

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

IAGES MEMBERSHIP IS MANDATORY

(For Membership Visit www.iages.in)

NON EXAM CATEGORY

To recognize their contribution to the field of minimal access surgery, the association awards the fellowship to senior laparoscopic surgeons without examination.

- Minimum 10 years experience practicing laparoscopic surgery post MS/ DNB/ MCh.
- Performed more than 250 laparoscopic surgeries supported with evidence or undertaking.
- Attend lectures on the first 2 days and live workshop on the 3rd day.

EXAM CATEGORY

- •Completed MS /DNB / MCh as of December 2019.
- •Performed 25 laparoscopic procedures independently / jointly/ under supervision
- •Attend lectures on the first 2 days and liveworkshop on the the 3rd day.
- •Attend endo-trainer and meet the professor sessions.

THEORY EXAMINATION

There will be short essay or MCQ type questions for 100 marks. Candidates are required to obtain a minimum of 50 marks to pass. Answers should be brief and to the point.

PRACTICAL EXAMINATION (CONSISTS OF TWO PARTS)

- 1.The skill assessment on endo-trainer is based on performing simple to advanced exercises, approximately 10 minutes for each candidate. Maximum of 50 marks is allotted to endo-trainer assessment. Each candidate will be assessed by one examiner.
- 2.Interview: assessment for approximately 10 minutes for each candidate. The candidates are divided into batches and are interviewed by two or more faculty members of IAGES.

A certificate of experience has to be obtained from the HOD of the hospital/Institution as a supportive document. Attach Xerox copies of MBBS, MS or DNB certificate and MCI registration certificate.

FIAGES: NON EXAMINATION CATEGORY

Suitable for those candidates working as faculty in teaching institution and all surgeons with more than 10 year experience in doing laparoscopy.

Already IAGES member or should become IAGES members Apply with an additional letter to the convener of the course clearly stating the number of laparoscopy done In the last 10 years Would be eligible to receive the FIAGES fellowship on satisfactory completion of the FIAGES course and the informal interview. Decision of Examiner panel is final..

DIBRUGARH

The vibrant city of Dibrugarh is considered the second most important place in Assam after Guwahati. Situated in the eastern most part of the state on the banks of the mighty Brahmaputra, the city is known for numerous tea estates and oil installations in the vicinity. ASSAM MEDICAL COLLEGE

Assam Medical College is a premier and the oldest medical college of the north eastern region. Dr. John Berry White (MRCS), a British surgeon of the East India Company and a retired Brigadier was the pioneer in sowing the seeds of this great institution. He donated his lifetime earnings of Rs 50000 for the establishment of Dr. John Berry White Medical School in 1901, In course of time this Medical School was upgraded to a fully fledged Medical College, the Assam Medical College and was formally inaugurated by the 1st Chief Minister of Assam, Late Lokopriya Gopinath Bordoloi on 3rd November 1947.

This medical college takes pride in being the nation's first medical college to have a Radiology department with fully functional X-Ray machines imported from England in 1910 Over the years it has become the primary tertiary care hospital, catering to a huge population of upper Assam and nearby states Nearly all the greatest luminaries of the medical field of Assam (and some from outside) has passed through the hallowed portals of this institution in their lifetime as students /faculty.
