Course Details

FALS – Fellowship in Advanced Laparoscopic Surgery

IAGES Advanced Fellowship Course (FALS):

IAGES will conduct a 3 days certification Fellowship course organized by Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, BLK Hospital & Manipal Hospital, New Delhi from 1st - 3rd December 2023. This course will focus on all the basics as well as advanced and recent aspects of Metabolic and Bariatric surgery. The course will be a balanced mix of didactic lectures by eminent faculty with ample time of discussion, video presentation, open house session symposia and direct informal interaction of groups with eminent faculty.

Live workshop on Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery

A live operating workshop will be held on 3rd December 2023. Commonly practiced advanced Metabolic and Bariatric procedures will be shown by eminent faculty who are masters in their field with emphasis on the current guidelines. The workshop shall be an open house interactive session with the delegate as the centre point.

Assessment for Certification

All the candidates will be assessed for the certificates after attending all the session. The method of assessment will depend on whether the candidate is in Examination category or Non-Examination Category.

Award of Fellowship Certificate

- Fellowship Certificates will be given only in person to the successful candidates in both the categories in a Grand Convocation Ceremony in the National congress visit: https://Iages.in
- Registration for IAGES 2024 Chennai Via <u>www.iageschennai.com</u>
- Delegate registration for the annual conference is mandatory to participate in the convocation.







Eligibility for FALS Course

IAGES Membership is Mandatory

IAGES Membership and registration to IAGES 2024 Chennai are prerequisites for obtaining fellowship certification. If you are not an IAGES member, you may apply for the IAGES membership on <u>www.iages.in</u> and give required details & Pay online.

Examination Category

All surgeons with a minimum of '**three years'** experience in Metabolic and Bariatric surgery after MS/DNB can apply in this category. Attendance is mandatory on all three days of course for all the candidates. Fellow should have an experience certificate from the Head of the Department (HOD), employer or self (if owning a hospital). Written examination will be conducted from 1st-3rd December 2023 and viva voce will be conducted on the 3rd December 2023.

The written examination will comprise of 100 MCQs with total marks of 100 and passing marks will be 50 marks. Viva voce will be for 100 marks and passing marks will be 50 marks.

Non-Examination category:

Surgeons who have been doing Metabolic and Bariatric surgery for 10 or more years are eligible for Non Examination Category candidates should have performed more than 100 bariatric surgeries and need to submit a logbook to substantiate the claim. Attendance is mandatory on all three days for all the candidates. Fellow should have experience certificate from the Head of the Department (HOD), employer or self (if owning a hospital). All the candidates will be interviewed by the IAGES board for final assessment before awarding fellowship.

Instructions to Course Participants

- Attendance is compulsory on all 3 days
- Participants are requested to sign in and sign out four times a day (in & out pre-lunch and in & out post lunch). It is mandatory to attend all sessions and stay in the hall till the proceedings are over.
- Participants are requested to reach Delhi on 1st December morning before 8:00 am without fail. Registration will be open on 1st December morning 7:00am.
