FIAGES GUIDELINES

TYPES OF FELLOWSHIP AND THEIR ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA.

IAGES MEMBERSHIP IS MUST

- Those who are not members may apply for membership online.
- See the website www.iages.in for more details.
- Post graduate degree in surgery is mandatory.
- Number of years of experience in laparoscopic surgery should be a minimum of 2 years (includes experience in laparoscopy as resident). A resident or junior consultant should obtain certificate of experience from the HOD of the hospital/Institution as a supportive document. Attach soft copies of MBBS, MS or DNB certificate and MCI registration certificate during membership registration.)
- Members of collaborating associations who have signed MOU with IAGES are also eligible. They are expected to get their
 application endorsed by the respective collaborating association prior to joining the course.

FIAGES: NON EXAMINATION CATEGORY

- Suitable for those candidates working as faculty in teaching institution and all surgeons with more than 10 year experience in doing laparoscopy.
- Already an IAGES member or should become IAGES member.
- Number of laparoscopy done in the last 10 years >100 would be eligible to receive the FIAGES fellowship on satisfactory completion of the FIAGES course and the informal interview.

FIAGES-NON-FELLOWSHIP CATEGORY

FIAGES: EXAMINATION CATEGORY

- Suitable for those with a minimum of 2 years experience in laparoscopic surgery (includes experience in laparoscopy as postgraduate / resident) after postgraduation.
- Fellow should have experience certificate from HOD, Employer or self if running own hospital.
- Log book: It is mandatory that candidates should submit a log book containing a minimum of 25 basic Laparoscopic cases performed or assisted by them duly countersigned by Senior Consultant/ HOD or self if working in his/her own set up at the time of interview.
- Online FIAGES is also open to Non-members and all surgical postgraduates and interested surgeons across the globe under the Non-Fellowship category wherein they are eligible to take this course and receive the certificate of completion of FIAGES course.
- They could register and participate in the annual national conference as postgraduates or Non-member category



- The written paper should have 100 MCQ questions (single best response type)
- Maximum marks: 100
- Minimum 50 marks is required to pass the written examination

PRACTICAL EXAMINATION

• PART 1: ENDOTRAINER SESSION

- The skill assessment on endo trainer on the bases of performing simple to advanced exercises. Duration: 10 minutes for each candidate.
- Maximum of 50 marks are allotted on endotrainer assessment.
- · Each candidate is examined by one examiner only

PART 2: INTERVIEW

- Interview/assessment for approximately 10 minutes on each candidate.
- The candidates are divided in to batches and are interviewed by the two or more senior most faculty members of IAGES depending upon the number of candidates.
- Maximum of 50 marks are allotted for the viva/interview.

Total marks for practical examinations are 100 (endotrainer assessment 50 marks and interview 50 marks). The **minimum of 50 marks** are required to **pass separately** in practical examination combining the endotrainer assessment and interview.

CITY & NEIGHBOURHOOD ATTRACTIONS



TAJ MAHAL

One of the seven wonders of the world, Taj Mahal is located on the banks of River Yamuna in <u>Agra</u>. It was built by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan as a memorial for his third wife, Mumtaz Mahal. It also houses the tomb of Shah Jahan himself. Constructed entirely out of white marble in the 17th century, Taj Mahal is one of the most beautiful monuments in the world. Every year visitors numbering more than the entire population of Agra pass through the magnificent gates to catch a glimpse of this breathtaking monument!



MEHTAB BAGH

Located just north to the glorious wonder called the Taj Mahal and overlooking the Agra Fort and Yamuna river on the opposite side, Mehtab Bagh is a rare retreat of natural bliss and one of the most scenic spots in Agra.



FATEHPUR SIKRI

Located at a distance of 40km from Agra, Fatehpur Sikri is a town in the Agra district and a famous tourist attraction. A city predominantly made of red sandstone, Fatehpur Sikri was founded in 1571 century by Mughal Emperor Akbar. It is essentially a fortified city built by the king and had been the capital of his Empire for fifteen years. Now a UNESCO world heritage site, it is home to Jodha Bai's Palace, Jama Mosque, Buland Darwaza, and Tomb of Salim Chisti among many other famous monuments. Derived from Arab and central Asian tent encampments, the Imperial Complex is a work of pavilions arranged in formal geometry on a piece of land.



AGRA FORT

Also known as Lal Qila, Fort Rouge or Red Fort of Agra, the Agra Fort is a UNESCO world heritage site. It is situated at a distance of about 2.5km northwest of the famous Taj Mahal. The construction of the massive fort of red sandstone by the banks of Yamuna river was started by emperor Akbar.



AKBAR"S TOMB

The Tomb of Akbar is an important and iconic Mughal architectural masterpiece, built in 1605 and 1613. It is located at Sikandra, in the suburbs of Agra, on the Mathura road (NH2), 8 km west of the city core. About a km away from the tomb, lies Mariam's Tomb, the tomb of Mariam-uz-Zamani, wife of the Mughal Emperor Akbar and the mother of Jahangir.
