

IAGES Fellowship Course

1AGES will conduct a 3 days fellowship course in Laparoscopy on 24, 25 &t 26 January 2020 at RAMA HOSPITAL, LAKHANPUR, KANPUR. The course will be balanced mix of didactic lectures by eminent faculty with ample time for discussion, video presentations, open house sessions, symposia and direct informal interactions of groups with eminent faculty (meet the professor). Participants will get ample time on endo trainer under close guidance and supervision of faculty to improve their hand -eye co-ordination by structured exercise.

On the third day, (i.e) 26 January 2020 a live operative workshop will be held at Rama Hospital, Lakhanpur, Kanpur. Commonly practiced basic and advanced laparoscopic procedures will be shown by eminent faculty who are masters in their field with emphasis on the correct techniques. The workshop shall be an open house interactive session with delegates as the central point. Lap appendix, Lap Cholecystectomy, Endoscopic TEP/TAPP Hernia and Lap Fundoplication are a few common procedures to be shown.

It gives a good opportunity for young surgeons to have interactive session which includes common basic and advanced procedure.

Endotrainer Sessions

The endo trainer sessions are very important part of the fellowship course. The session will be for 90 minutes and will be supervised by a faculty member in batches of 6-8 candidates so that there can be a close interaction. During the session they will be trained on performance of specified task and specific exercises including endo knotting and suturing. On the last day the evaluation will be on the same exercises.

Non Exam Category

- To recognize their contribution to the field of minimal access surgery, the association awards the fellowship to senior laparoscopic surgeons without examination.
- Minimum 10 years experience practicing laparoscopic surgery post- MS/DNB/Mch.
- Performed more than 250 laparoscopic surgeries supported with evidence or undertaking.
- Attend lectures on the first 2 days and live workshop on the 3rd day.

Exam Category

- 2 Years waiting period Post PG removed
- 2 Years of Laparoscopic surgery training as a resident.
- Performed 25 laparoscopic procedures independently or jointly.
- Attend lectures on the first 2 days and live workshop on the 3rd day.
- Attend endo-trainer and meet.

Exam Patterns

Written exam

- There will be a short essay or MCQ type questions for 100 marks.
- Candidates are required to obtain a minimum of 50 marks to pass.
- Answers should be brief and to the point.

Practical Exam (In two parts)

- The skill assessment on endo-trainer is based on performing simple to advanced exercises like, Transfer to beads, Making pile surgery cubes, Intra-Corporeal suturing approximately 10 minutes for each candidate. Maximum of 50 marks endo-trainer assessment. Each candidate will be assessed by is allotted to one
- Interview / assessment for approximately 10 minutes for each candidate. The candidates are divided into batches and are interviewed by two or more faculty members of IAGES. Maximum of 50 marks.



Instructions to the participants

- Registration starts at 8 am on 24th January 2020.
- Exam category delegates will have an exam on 25th January 2020. (Day 2)
- Live operative workshop at the conference venue will start at 8.00 am sharp and will end at 2.00 pm on 26th January 2020. (Day 3)
- Attendance is compulsory for all FIAGES course participants on all days.
- Sign in and sign out register will be maintained. The marks will be awarded for attendance as well.
