MAS Guidelines & Recommendations- Revision Update on 17th-18th March 2018







This report captures two day programme, 17th-18th March 2018 of presentations and interactive dialogue at the First Meeting-Minimal Access Surgery Guidelines and Recommendations "Revision – Update". The event brought together some 65 experts across the country from the field of Minimal Access Surgery. Minimal access surgery has grown roots far and wide and we are fortunate to be in the midst of what promises to be an era that transformed surgical practice.

In 2000, a set of recommendatory guidelines for introduction and safe practice of Minimal Access Surgery in India were prepared by Indian Association Of Gatrointestinal Endosurgeons (IAGES) . These guidelines were prepared on request of Ministry Of Health, Indian Council Of Medical Research (ICMR), Indian Medical Association and Medical Council Of India (MCI). It was on Monday the 15th July,2002 at Rashtrapati Bhawan, New Delhi where the first Minimal Access Surgery Guidelines and Recommendations book was released by former President Of India Shri K.R Narayanan.

The conference began with welcome address by Dr. Pradeep Chowbey Chairman, Minimal Institute Of Metabolic Access and Bariatric Surgery, Max Super Speciality Hospital, Saket, New Delhi. Dr. Pradeep Chowbey highlighted, in past three decades, Minimal Access Surgery has taken a giant leap and is reflected in the new concepts of surgical delivery across the world. The new revolution has taken place and we are in the phase of Renaissance — A period of new growth in Minimal Access Surgery in the

country. He concluded saying this academic venture is our unwavering commitment to create an inspiring environment for the surgeons to keep abreast of knowledge and skills in minimal access surgery for the benefit of patients.

The two day session continued with interactive discussions, presentations. The guidelines were distributed among 65 experts. Guidelines describe the current, best possible standard in diagnostics and therapy. In this context, guidelines were evidence based and were formulated by panel of experts who were able to grade the recommendations (level of evidence) according to established criteria of evidence-based medicine (EBM). The fundamental proposal for reliable guidelines is the availability of quality published studies ranking high in the classification of the EBM. We created 17 groups to discuss 17 topics. One group Coordinator for each group consisting of 3-5 members to address one specific chapter was assigned. Group Coordinator of each group delivered their presentations which was followed by discussions among all the 65 experts to formulate the revised Minimal Access Surgery Guidelines and Recommendations.

This national platform provided a valuable networking opportunity and set the stage for further cooperation among all the stalwarts in the field of minimal access surgery across India to formulate the revised Minimal Access Surgery Guidelines and Recommendations. This meeting gave a new horizon for minimal access surgery and aimed to open new gates of opportunities for novice laparoscopic surgeons.


A one day Endoscopy workshop in Midnapore on the 11th may 2018
